The Arizona State Rifle and Pistol Association is hosting a Garand/Springfield/Military (GSM) Vintage Rifle shoot at the Ben Avery Shooting Facility (Carefree Hwy & I-17) High Power Range, 200 yd line.

- **Sunday 18-Mar-2012, 1:00 PM**
- **Sunday 22-Apr-2012, 1:00 PM**
- **Sunday 20-May -2012, 1:00 PM**
- **11-Nov-2012, Veteran's Day event!**

Course of fire (all at 200 yds) will be:

- 5 sighter shots prone
- 10 shots prone slow fire
- 10 shots prone rapid fire
- 10 Shots Standing

Open to all safe shooters, beginner's welcome! Ear & eye protection required. Bring your rifle, a sling, min 35 rds ammo and 1 or 2 stripper clips if you have them. A carpet or mat to shoot prone and long sleeve shirt or jacket. Shooters will alternate shooting and working targets. \$15 Fee for adults, under 18 free.
