2012 shoots: Saturday, 31-March, Sun 30-Sep, 9AM

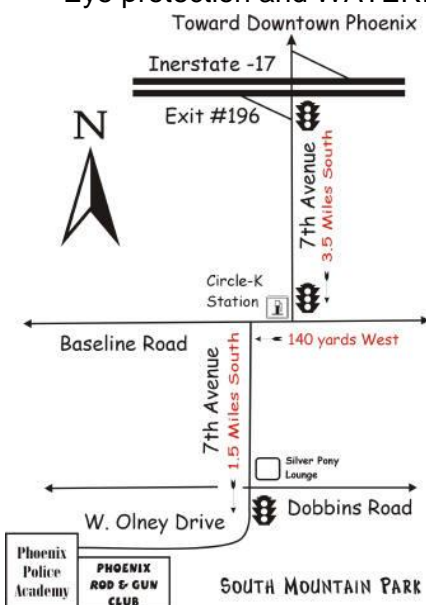

- African Big Bore Rifles: Bolt, Double, Single shot etc any big African caliber, 9.3 & up. – Make sure its zeroed for your hunting preference. Plains game stages use any appropriate rifle.
- Bring at least 20 rds of full power ammo and 10 for plains game
- Safari equipment such as shooting sticks permitted. Dress as you would for a hunt in this weather. Pith helmets optional!
- Multiple stages. Details announced on shoot-day, Stationary, charging or moving targets and shoot/don't shoot scenarios.

- Reasonable dangerous game hunting distances, 10yds to 100 yds.
- Targets will be full size and reduced size African dangerous or plains game animal targets.
- Hit/Miss/Wound & shoot/no-shoot, power factor scoring, to judge your skills, but this is a fun shoot not a championships.
- Carefully aimed shots only. Participants will alternate shooting, scoring and marking targets. Bring Ear & Eye protection and WATER! 9AM start, arrive an hour early to help with set up.

- Fee \$20, (discount for PRGC members). Limit 40 shooters, email Arizona@rifleshooting.org to pre-register or for questions.
